Car Show (turn over for Drag Race)



Please park in the area identified above for Show Cars and Car Show Trailers.

After you are parked register at the registration booth next to the Performance Racing School Building.

Awards are scheduled for 3:00 PM

Judging will begin at 11:00 AM - If you are interested in helping contact show staff

Award classes will be determined on day of show based on cars entered. The goal is to put an equal number of cars in each class.

Cars will be judged on cleanliness and quality of: Paint/Body, Engine, Wheels/Tires, Interior.

If hood is closed no points will be awarded for engine. Trunk and doors do not need to be open.

On a time available basis a show cars can participate in a fun run down the quarter mile track. Cars will have to pass a tech inspection based on NHRA rules. Fee is \$5.00 and will be collected in the staging lanes. The runs will be in the afternoon starting around 4:00 pm and will be announced over the loud speaker.

Door prizes will be drawn throughout the day. Tickets are available \$1.00 each or 6 for \$5.00. Check the board in the registration area for winning numbers.

Proceeds from the show will benefit the Hot Rod Hall of Fame Scholarship Fund.

Drag Race (turn over for Car Show)



Upon entry park in either of the Drag Race Parking areas.

Engines cannot be started before 9:00 AM and all races must conclude by 5:00 PM.

All classes are open to any year GM model or engine:

Street Rod - 12.00 and slower, no electronics, .5 full tree

Hot Rod - 9.00 to 13.99, no electronics, .5 full tree

Electronics - 7.50 to 11.99, electronics, .5 full tree

LS/LT - Any car powered by an LS or LT engine, no electronics, street DOT tires

Prior to racing you will need to pass a tech inspection and sign a waiver in the Pro Shop to obtain a wristband. Do not come to the staging lanes until your class is called.

Basic requirements to pass tech:

No cracked windshields, a radiator overflow is required, and must have door handles.

No short pants, tank tops or open toed shoes for driver.

Convertibles and cars running faster than 13.99 require a SNELL approved helmet.

Cars running 11.49 and faster must have a roll bar and 5 point harness.
